There are so many things that hinge on that SLP – the 180° principal in the 2H world – even though it is the most efficient cast.

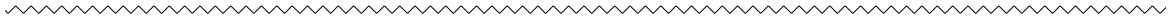
When things deviate from that path – then we get the faults and a lot of our tasks are based on SLP and then changing the delivery.
